ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

RULES & CONDITIONS

1. Membership of this category is open to friends, associates and family of full members of Didsbury Golf Club.
2. Members are required to pay the annual subscription fee as determined annually by the Directors of the Club. As at 1st April 2010 this fee was £65.
3. Members must pay a green fee, in advance, for each round of golf they play. As at 1st April 2010, green fees for Associated members are £15 Monday to Friday and £17 at weekends.
4. Members may sign in up to 3 visitors at any one time, providing a green fee is paid in advance for each visitor. These are the same rates as for the Associate member.
5. An Associate member may play in all Wednesday and certain Sunday competitions, providing their green fee and competition fee is paid in advance. Associate members are also entitled to enter the Midweek Summer Fourball knockout competition.
6. Places in competitions must be booked, a maximum of 7 days in advance of the competition.
7. Associate members and their visitors may use the practice facilities of the Club, but only on days when they have paid a green fee.
8. Members may take advantage of the members bar discount scheme, providing they pay the annual bar credit at the commencement of each subscription year. As at 1st April 2010, the annual credit required is £50.
9. Associate members may not vote at Club meetings or hold any office within the Club, but are otherwise free to enjoy all other members' benefits.
10. Priority over external applicants will be given to Associate Members who wish to convert to 5, 6 or 7-Day Membership, if vacancies occur.
